



FLASH AT-HOME ***Students & Family Expectations***

- Overview:
 - Remote FLASH will run Monday through Thursday for four consecutive weeks.
 - FLASH Jr will be offered for incoming Grades 2-4.
 - FLASH Pro will be offered for incoming Grades 5-8.
 - ALL students will build their own program of four courses during registration.
 - Sports Academy will be blended into the FLASH program and NOT run separately.
 - FLASH will offer a reduced rate of \$375 for 2020.

- Daily Expectations
 - Flexible class schedules, so students/parents can choose when to participate.
 - All teachers & students will use Google Classroom
 - Teachers post daily assignments by 9:00 AM.
 - FLASH Teachers will use a blend of their own pre-recorded video lessons, instructional videos from other online resources, and other Google Education resources (Classroom, Docs, Slides, etc.).
 - Teachers may use live-video conferencing to supplement the course activities.
 - Pre-recorded video and Google Classroom allow you and your family to work when you want and where you want throughout the fun summer!

 - Teachers will design age-appropriate lessons that take approximately 20-30 minutes.
 - Teachers will do their best to create independent activities that require minimal parental involvement.
 - Teachers will “check in” twice each day through Google Classroom, between 9:30AM - 1:30PM, to provide clarity, answer questions, and offer feedback. Teachers are not expected to be immediately available for the entire 4-hour duration.

 - SAFETY
 - Parent(s)/Guardian(s) must be available to supervise activities for safety.
 - Students will use age-appropriate materials, so classes will be modified accordingly. For example, *Cooking* will NOT require the use of the stove, oven, or sharp utensils.

 - MATERIALS
 - Executive Orders do not allow FLASH/Summit Schools to distribute materials.
 - Required course materials will be posted online PRIOR to registration. Teachers strongly recommend you purchase materials as soon as possible.
 - Teachers will make every attempt to use common household items. Some courses may require additional materials. For example, *Sewing* may need a needle or specific type of fabric.
