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It is important to remember that FLASH is run by the Summit Board of Education, and we will follow the directions of our Board of Education and Superintendent of Schools.

- As of today, FLASH is planning to run on its regular schedule. If FLASH is delayed or cancelled, we will let you know ASAP.
- Sports Academy & FLASH registration are open.

Please read the information below prior to choosing your payment method:

- FLASH is extending the Early Bird discount through June 1.
- At this current time, **we strongly recommend choosing cash or check.**
- If you are paying cash or check, please do **NOT** send payment, yet. FLASH Coordinators and our FLASH Secretary are currently working from home, and we cannot process payment at this time. We will send an email later on as to when we can accept payment.
- If you are paying by credit card, you can do this online. Please read the next two items prior to registering.
  - If FLASH is cancelled, we will refund your tuition amount. At this time, it is unclear if we are able to refund the 3% Credit Card fee.
  - If a refund is needed, there is no timetable for this refund. A FLASH refund can only be processed after SBOE Central Office employees return to work. Please be patient as our employees' responsibilities will be focused on critical district operations, first. They will refund FLASH tuition when the district returns to normal day-to-day operations.
